## DESIGN KICK OFF CEREMONY FOR DANCEWAVE'S NEW HOME IN DOWNTOWN BROOKLYN

**Brooklyn, NY** - Dancewave (DW) will host a design kick off ceremony on Nov. 12, 2013 at 11 a.m. to celebrate Dancewave's new location on 182 4th Ave., in downtown Brooklyn. DW invites the public to view the future construction site on Degraw and Fourth. The building will serve as home to DW's growing school, organization, and cultural center. This future Brooklyn landmark is scheduled to open Fall 2016.

Special guest speakers will include Brooklyn President, Marty Markowitz and Council Member, Steve Levin. Dancewave Company I will perform TRIO an excerpt from Pupil Suite by Andrea Miller of Gallim with music by Balkan Beatbox.

**The new Dancewave Center will be a community hub offering dance training for all ages, affordable rehearsal space, community events, performances, professional development workshops, and artist talks.**

The planned 3,600 sq. ft. center will contain two dance studios and a performance space seating 80 to 100 persons. The new space will also expand the number of participants from 3,000 to over 4,000 annually through increased classes and community performances.

The location of the new Dancewave Center, at Fourth Avenue and DeGraw Street, will affirm Dancewave's place at the vanguard of matching cultural excitement and excellence to the hundreds of millions of dollars of housing and commercial development reshaping the face of Fourth Avenue.
